From Coach Joe:

From Ally: Athletic trainer

- · She is associated with Emory Healthcare and handles all injuries
- · If a player is injured, she can get a quick turnaround on care through Emory.
- Unless it is an emergency, strongly encourages us to go through her as the Emory experts can be sure to assess care and when the player can return. A primary care physician is not trained for sports injuries and may lead to the player being out longer than necessary.
- Dragonfly: can go through website or download the app
  - VERY IMPORTANT: make sure the athlete's profile is complete by Tuesday to join practice.
  - If your student played another sport, still double check as sometimes Dekalb will add new forms that must be completed.
  - Make sure your player's physical is up to date and won't expire during the season.
  - If anyone needs help with the insurance requirements, let her know.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> graders must complete a new profile for Lakeside High School (they do not have access to the middle school dragonfly account)
